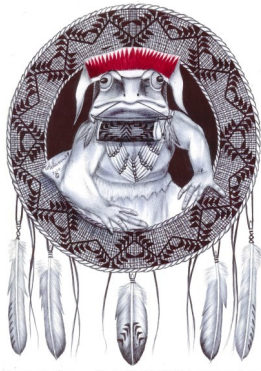


Yurok Wellness Court

Yurok Elder Advocacy

Assistance to elders experiencing abuse such as physical, financial, neglect and isolation. Services include but are not limited to:

- ◆ Crisis Intervention & Case Monitoring
- ◆ Emergency Assistance & Resource Referral
- ◆ Orientation to Criminal Justice System
- ◆ Court Accompaniment
- ◆ Assistance in finding Relief & Restitution



Hey-wech-ek' Program

(I Survive)

Assistance and services for victims and survivors of domestic violence, sexual assault, dating violence, stalking, and family violence.

Available program services:

- ◆ Court Advocacy & Accompaniment
- ◆ Assistance with Restraining Orders & Related Paperwork
- ◆ Administering Client Needs Assessments & Safety Planning
- ◆ Transportation & Relocation Services
- ◆ Coordinating Counseling & Support Groups
- ◆ Referrals to Outside Assistance such as Temporary Shelter & Housing
- ◆ Supervised Visitation & Safe Exchange



Yurok Reentry Program

The Program works with eligible Yurok tribal members released from state and local county correctional facilities.

- ◆ Development of Reentry Case Plans
- ◆ Assistance with meeting legal Obligations
- ◆ Correspondence
- ◆ Accessing Services
- ◆ Inpatient Treatment & Sober Living
- ◆ Release Packages & Transportation Assistance
- ◆ Expungement of Criminal Records, where eligible



Yurok Legal Access Center

The Yurok Legal Access Center provides assistance to parties in various legal actions including, but not limited to:

- ◆ Child Custody & Divorce
- ◆ Restraining Orders
- ◆ Evictions
- ◆ Name Changes
- ◆ Small Claims Cases
- ◆ Filling Out Forms & Preparing for Court
- ◆ Assistance with State Court Cases
- ◆ Mediation Services
- ◆ Administrative Process Assistance



Yurok Child Support Services

Yurok Child Support Services offers services to parents and guardians to help them meet their responsibilities to their children.

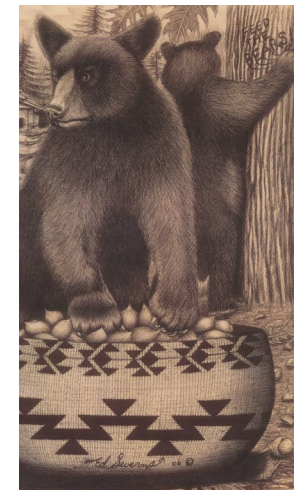
- ◆ Locate a Parent
