Memorandum of Points and Authorities (Yurok Tribal Code)

1. Stay of Execution:

The Court has the authority to stay the execution of a judgment or order. [YTC 24.10.200]. No explicit maximum time frame is stipulated for the length of the stay.

2. Respondent's Motion for Stay:

A Respondent has five business days to file a request for a stay of execution of judgment or order. The notice of motion will automatically extend the Respondent's time to plead by five business days after the service of a written notice of the order denying the motion. [YTC 24.10.200].

3. Extension of Time:

The Tribal Court may extend a party's time to plead or respond by up to an additional 15 business days for good cause. If the adverse party consents, further extensions may also be granted. [YTC 24.10.220].
